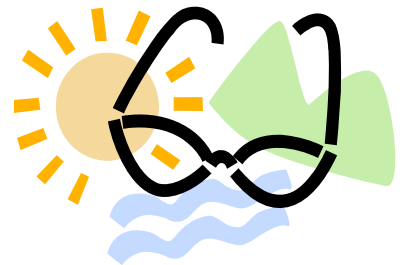

_____ **Rules & Regulations** - recommends and prepares amendments to the existing Bylaws to the Board of Directors.
