

22. It shall be the parents responsibility to familiarize their children with the rules and regulations of the swimming pool.
23. All changes or additions must be posted and sent to the membership after the Swimming Pool Committee, Rules and Regulations Committee, and Board of Directors approval.
24. The above rules are made for the enjoyment and use of every member and the care of the swimming areas. All persons using the pools must abide by these rules and regulations. Violations will be noted by other members, life-guards, or the Swimming Pool Committee, and reported to the Club Manager in writing. Offenders could be subject to disciplinary action by the Board of Directors.

Swimming Pool Committee

Tennis Courts

- 1) Direction, Management, and use of the tennis courts are vested in the Board of Directors/General Manager.
- 2) The use of the tennis courts is restricted to club members, their families and in addition, their guests who reside outside of Johnston County (Exception #3).
- 3) Resident non-member guests are permitted four visits per calendar year.
- 4) If others are waiting to play, limit your playing time to one set.
- 5) Tennis shoes and shirts must be worn at all times while on the courts.
- 6) Children must be tended and not distracting to other players.
- 7) All trash is to be disposed of properly.
- 8) Anyone using the tennis courts does so at his own risk.

Pool and Tennis Rules and Regulations



Swimming Pool Operation Rules

1. **GENERAL:** Direction, management and use of the swimming pool and the wading pool are vested in the Board of Directors/General Manager. For the protection of those using the pool one or more lifeguards will be employed. Every person who uses either pool shall abide by the lifeguard's instructions and directions at all times.
2. The pools shall not be used at any time **unless a lifeguard is on duty.** Exceptions may be given for Adults only with swimming at their own risk.
3. The pools will be open and a lifeguard on duty, weather permitting, each day during the season as follows:
 Monday-Saturday. 11:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
 Sunday 1:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.
 The Swimming Pool Committee may change the hours depending on weather conditions. Time change must be posted.
4. **Anyone who uses either pool does so at his own risk.**
5. The use of the pool is restricted to club members and families (Article 7, Section 2) and their non-member guests (children included) (Exception #6). Guests must be accompanied by a member. Dues paying members who are single will be permitted to bring a guest of the opposite sex without charge.
6. Guest Charge - will be any day of operation other than Holidays. Guests will be charged \$3; in-county guests are restricted to once a quarter and out-of-county guests are unlimited. Members will be responsible for notifying lifeguard of all guests. Any violations will result in suspension of guest privileges for the remainder of the year. Member's accounts will be charged for all guests. Please sign them in when entering pool.

7. Children under 9 years of age are not allowed in the pool at any time unless accompanied by an adult of at least **16 years of age or older**. **The responsibility of parents, guardians and adults who accompany children to the pools continues while they are in or near the pools.**

8. Members dressed in swimming suits are required to stay within the swimming pool enclosure and other designated areas and shall not appear at the Clubhouse.

9. Bathers must supply their own towels.

10. All persons must have feet clean and free of grass and foreign matter before entering the pools.

11. No coolers, bottles or glasses shall be permitted inside the swimming pool enclosure. Refreshments will be served only in paper cups or cans. After use, cups, cans, cigarettes, and all trash must be deposited in receptacles provided for such purpose so that the premises may be kept clean and attractive. All food and beverage must come from the club and may not be brought to the pool from the outside. The cooperation of members is expected and will be appreciated.

12. All bathers will use swimming pool restroom facilities.

13. No running about the deck, no pushing others into the pool, only one person on the diving board at a time, and no diving before the previous diver has cleared the diving area. Throwing or playing with hard objects will not be permitted in the pool or pool area.

14. Each hour, 10 minutes on the hour, there will be a 10 minute rest period for everyone under 16 years of age. During this break only those 16 years or older may swim. This period is designated to give the younger bathers a rest, break the horseplay, and give the adults an opportunity to swim without young people in the water.

15. Pool Rentals -

1) Child pool parties during regular hours - \$25.00 + 1 lifeguard per 10 children at \$10.00 per hour. Club functions after pool hours - specified rate for event. Private parties - rental through Club office at \$300.00 + 1 lifeguard per 10 adults at \$10.00 per hour. Lifeguard fees are paid directly to lifeguards by member having the party. Adult party guidelines and fees will be the same as

general clubhouse rental rules. Adult parties must use pool after regular pool hours.

2) Member may rent for members use only (or your child in case of child party).

3) Club Management must approve all rentals.

4) You must clean up after your own party.

5) Birthday parties should contact the Club.

16. No dogs, cats, animals or other pets will be permitted in the pool, pool enclosure or on Clubhouse grounds.

17. All persons entering the pool enclosure must register upon entering the gate.

18. The pool will normally and usually open on Memorial Day and close on Labor Day each year.

19. Baby Sitter Rules -

1) A baby sitter fee of \$25.00 per family will be charged or \$3.50 per day.

2) All baby sitters must be registered with the General Manager and Pool Manager.

3) Babysitters must be 16 years old or older (or a letter from parents-details later)

20. Babies in the Pool -

1) No disposable diapered children in the large pool. They may use baby pool.

2) Non-toilet trained children should have swim diapers and rubber pants on in order to swim in the big pool.

3) Young toilet trained children should be monitored by parent to minimize accidents.

4) In the event of an accident the pool must be cleared and shocked.

5) Please be considerate of all who are swimming and closely monitor your children.

21. Pool Cleanliness -

1) If you eat in the pool area please clean up behind yourself. Wipe off or spray off your tables so the next group can use it.

2) Please pick up drink cans and wrappers around your chairs that belong to you.
